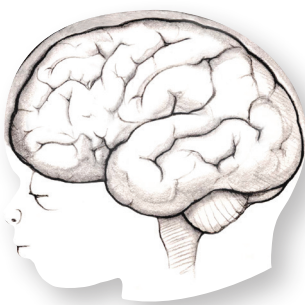




IF YOUR PREGNANCY IS HEALTHY, IT'S BEST TO STAY PREGNANT FOR AT LEAST 39 WEEKS.

39 TO 40 WEEKS

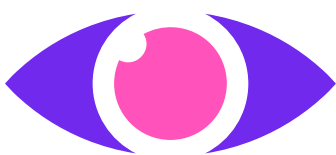

Babies born too early may have breathing problems and jaundice after birth.



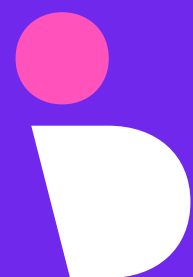
EYES AND EARS
