• 2013 - McLeod Home Health has been named as one of the Top 100 Home Health agencies in the country. The only performance recognition of its kind in the home health industry, the 2013 Top 100 HomeCare Elite acknowledgement places McLeod Home Health in the top one percent of home health agencies in the United States. In addition, McLeod Home Health is the only agency in South Carolina included in the Top 100 ranking. HomeCare Elite is a compilation of the top-performing home health agencies by OCS HomeCare and DecisionHealth. Winners are ranked by an analysis of publicly available performance measures in quality outcomes, best practice (process measure) implementation, patient experience (Home Health CAHPS), quality improvement and consistency, and financial performance. Out of 9,969 home health agencies considered, only 2,496 are elite.

The grades are derived from expert analysis of publicly available data using 26 evidence-based, national measures of hospital safety. The Leapfrog Group is an independent, national, not-for-profit organization founded by the nation's leading employers and private healthcare experts. The mission of the Leapfrog Group is to encourage giant "leaps" forward in the safety, quality and affordability of healthcare in the United States by promoting transparency and value-based hospital incentives.
- 2012 McLeod Regional Medical Center and McLeod Loris were ranked among the top hospitals around the state in the new Consumer Reports hospital safety ratings, according to their Hospital Safety Rating Article in the August, 2012 edition. These Ratings are based on six categories of patient safety: hospital-acquired infections, readmissions, communication about medications and discharge, CT scanning, complications, and mortality. The data comes from the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, state governments, and the Leapfrog Group, an independent organization that collects information on hospital safety.
- 2012 McLeod Regional Medical Center is one of the top performing hospitals in the country for 2011, and has been recognized for its participation in a national project that resulted in saving lives and reducing healthcare spending by more than \$4 billion.
