## CHILDREN – McLeod Children's Hospital Expansion GOAL - \$2 million

McLeod Children's Hospital is one of only four Children's Hospitals in the state of South Carolina. As McLeod is continuously growing its footprint in the Pee Dee Region, we provide care for more than 56,000 children annually. To meet the growing demand of our region, McLeod Children's Hospital provides a broad range of services that touch the lives of children and their families. In order to meet the future needs of our region, McLeod Health will be investing more than \$20 million to construct a major expansion of the McLeod Children's Hospital.

The new children's hospital will include private and open neonatal intensive care unit rooms, pediatric intensive care unit rooms, pediatric pharmacy, milk preparation area, family waiting room and lobby.

- Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU): 50 private patient rooms; all rooms will be private with glass doors; some will be larger than others. Of the 50 private rooms, 28 rooms will be open rooms for the smaller sicker babies.
- **Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU):** 10 larger family friendly patient rooms that are able to accommodate overnight stay for families.
- **Pediatric Satellite Pharmacy:** Conveniently located pharmacy on in-patient floor to provide immediate child appropriate dosages
- Family Waiting Areas: Larger family waiting room conveniently located near PICU and NICU
- Renovated Rooms: Newborn Nursery, Children's Hospital General patient rooms, Labor and Delivery patient rooms
- Milk Preparation Area: Certified milk tech will prepare feedings for babies. There will be space to store breast milk, draw up the appropriate number of feedings and mix any prescribed additives to the formula/breast milk.
