

Summary of Compassionate Care Policy

Who May Be Eligible

McLeod Health patients whose household income is at or below 300% of the federal poverty guidelines.

Financial Assistance Available

McLeod Health may reduce charges for emergency and other non-elective medically necessary care to patients who meet the criteria for financial assistance (up to 100% of the charges). Eligible patients will not be charged more than the amounts generally billed to patients with insurance coverage. This includes care by the following entities and locations, only:

McLeod Health-Clarendon
McLeod Health-Darlington
McLeod Health-Dillon
McLeod Health-Loris/Seacoast
McLeod Family Medicine Center
McLeod Hospice Services
McLeod Hospice Services

Services provided and/or billed by private or independent entities, practice groups or other providers (including but not limited to Emcare, Pee Dee Pathology, Carolina Radiological Associates, Florence Radiological Associates, Pediatrix Medical Group, American Anesthesiology, Mednax Services and TeamHealth) are not covered by this policy. Patients should address any payment questions or concerns directly with the private physician/provider practice.
