

Financial Assistance Policy Summary

Eligibility Criteria

McLeod Health patients whose household income is at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Financial Assistance Available

McLeod Health may reduce charges incurred for emergencies and other non-elective medically necessary care to patients who meet the financial assistance requirements (up to 100% of the charges). Eligible patients will not be charged more than the Amount Generally Billed (AGB) to patients that have insurance coverage. The financial assistance includes care received from the following:
